Museum Pass Program for Libraries

The USS Constitution Museum's Pass Program is offered FREE to public libraries in Massachusetts and the Northeast.

Terms of Discount: One pass allows free admission for up to nine people per day. Appropriate for all ages.

Enrollment: Libraries can request up to four passes. Each pass is good for one year from the date of sign-up. Once the enrollment period has expired, contact us to renew and continue using your passes.

Publicity: Participating libraries are expected to communicate the availability of the USS Constitution Museum Pass to their patrons through promotional means (newsletters, signage, display, website, catalog, local media, etc) as available.

About the Museum: The USS Constitution Museum, located in the Charlestown Navy Yard, serves as the memory and educational voice of USS *Constitution* by collecting, preserving, and interpreting the stories of "Old Ironsides" and the people associated with her. The Museum offers a variety of engaging activities, exhibits, and programs, including our interactive family exhibit, *All Hands on Deck: A Sailor's Life in 1812*, where visitors can furl a sail, sleep in a hammock, and scrub the deck as they join *Constitution's* crew in 1812!
