Sail Boston Express



\$15.00/One-Way Ticket

Luxury bus connection serving several areas that will transport you into either Castle Island (June 17) or the Seaport District (June 17-21). Advance reservation required. Online ticket sales only.

Shuttle connection service to/from the Seaport District, North Station, and Charlestown from June 17-21. Advance reservation recommended. Online ticket sales only.

Service allows for hop-on hop-off service for each day during Sail Boston (one price all day service.)

MBTA Transportation – Specific to Sail Boston

All MBTA passes can be purchased at ticket offices located at South Station, Back Bay, and North Station from June 5th-21st. The Shuttles to Ships, Day Sailor Pass, and Commodore Pass will also be sold during the event at major subway stations. **These passes will not work for the water shuttle.**

Day Sailor Pass

Valid for unlimited travel on the Bus and Subway for one 24-hour period during the Sail Boston event, and unlimited use on the following MBTA Sail Boston express shuttle buses June 17-21, 2017:

- JFK/UMass to Castle Island: Runs June 17 only
- Sullivan to Charlestown Navy Yard: Runs June 17-21

Commuter Rail Day Sailor Pass



\$35.00/Ticket

Valid for unlimited travel on the Commuter Rail, Bus and Subway for one 24-hour period on either Saturday, June 17th or Sunday, June 18th. Also valid for unlimited use on the following MBTA Sail Boston express shuttle buses June 17-21, 2017:

- JFK/UMass to Castle Island: Runs June 17 only
- Sullivan to Charlestown Navy Yard: Runs June 17-21

Commodore Pass



\$25.00/Ticket

Valid for unlimited travel on the Bus and Subway for 7 days during the Sail Boston event, and unlimited use on the following MBTA Sail Boston express shuttle buses June 17-21, 2017:

- JFK/UMass to Castle Island: Runs June 17 only
- Sullivan to Charlestown Navy Yard: Runs June 17-21

Boston Harbor Cruise Transportation – Specific to Sail Boston

Cross Harbor Ferry and the Water Shuttle will not be running on June 17th due to the Parade of Sail. MBTA passes specific to Sail Boston will not work for the water shuttle.

Sail Boston Cross Harbor Ferry



\$15.00/Adult One-Way
\$20.00/Adult Round Trip
\$5.00/Children Ages 3-11

An easy - and breezy - way to get between Tall Ship sites across the Harbor. Direct service between Pier 4 - South Boston and Pier 1 - Charlestown Navy Yard.

WHEN: June 18 – 21, Leaves every 30 minutes, on the hour and half hour. Service begins at 10:30 AM; ends at 8:00 PM.

LOCATION: Harbor Ferry departs Pier 1. Drops off at Pier 4 in South Boston.

HOW LONG: Ride is 15 minutes.

Water Shuttle



\$3.50/Day Ticket
Fare is covered by
MBTA 1- and 7- day
passes.

The Water shuttle is a ferry that takes passengers from the Charlestown Navy Yard to Long Wharf, by the Aquarium.

WHERE: Located behind Museum building on Pier 4. Drops off at Long Wharf (Aquarium stop on the Blue Line).

WHEN: Leaves every 30 minutes, on the 15 and 45.

WEEKDAYS: Service begins at 6:45 AM, ends at 8:15 PM

Additional service every 15 minutes from 7-9 AM and 4-6:30 PM

WEEKENDS: Service begins at 10:15 AM, ends at 6:15 PM

HOW LONG: Ride is 10 minutes.
