
Description of Materials Used in Building USS *Constitution*

To build USS *Constitution*, the best materials were brought to Hartt's shipyard in Boston, Massachusetts. *Constitution*'s builders used wood from all over the United States to build her strong hull. Each type of wood was ideally suited for its use.



The deck beams were of white oak and the deck planking was made of southern pitch pine.

White oak from New England formed her backbone or keel.
