Sailor's Valentine

A sailor's valentine is an art form made from arranging small seashells in a symmetrical pattern. They were a popular souvenir purchased by sailors for their sweethearts left on shore and usually featured a symbol of love or a romantic message close to its center. While the name suggests that the sailors crafted these designs themselves, most were created and purchased on the island of Barbados.

Materials:

Sailor's valentine coloring sheet

Scissors

Crayons or colored pencils

Directions:

- 1. Print and cut out the valentine template
- 2. Fold the template in half
- 3. Color in the seashell design
- 4. Write a message on the inside of the card, such as: forget me not, think of me, ever thine, and forever yours.
