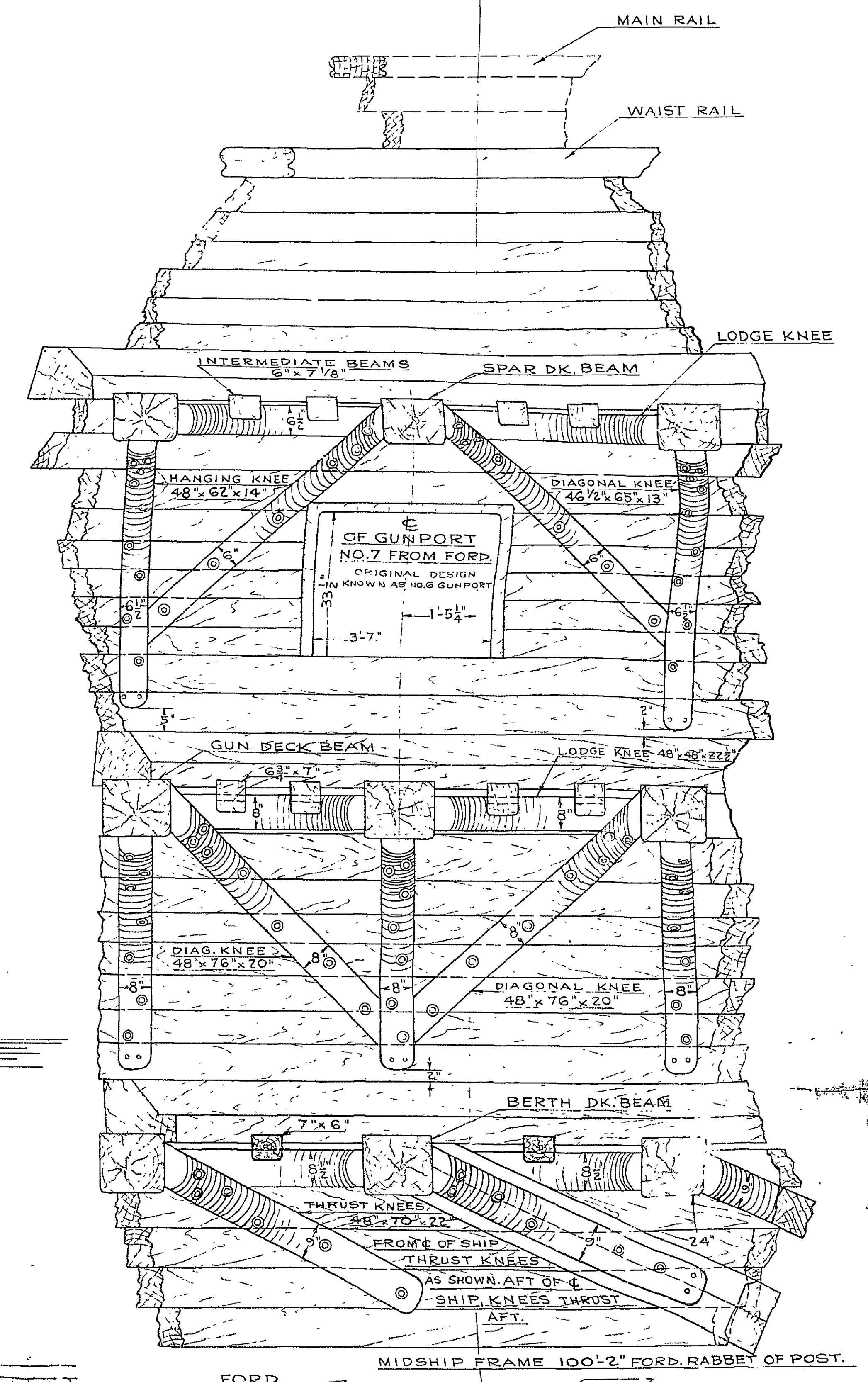


ELEVATION
STARBOARD SIDE, LOOKING OUTBOARD.

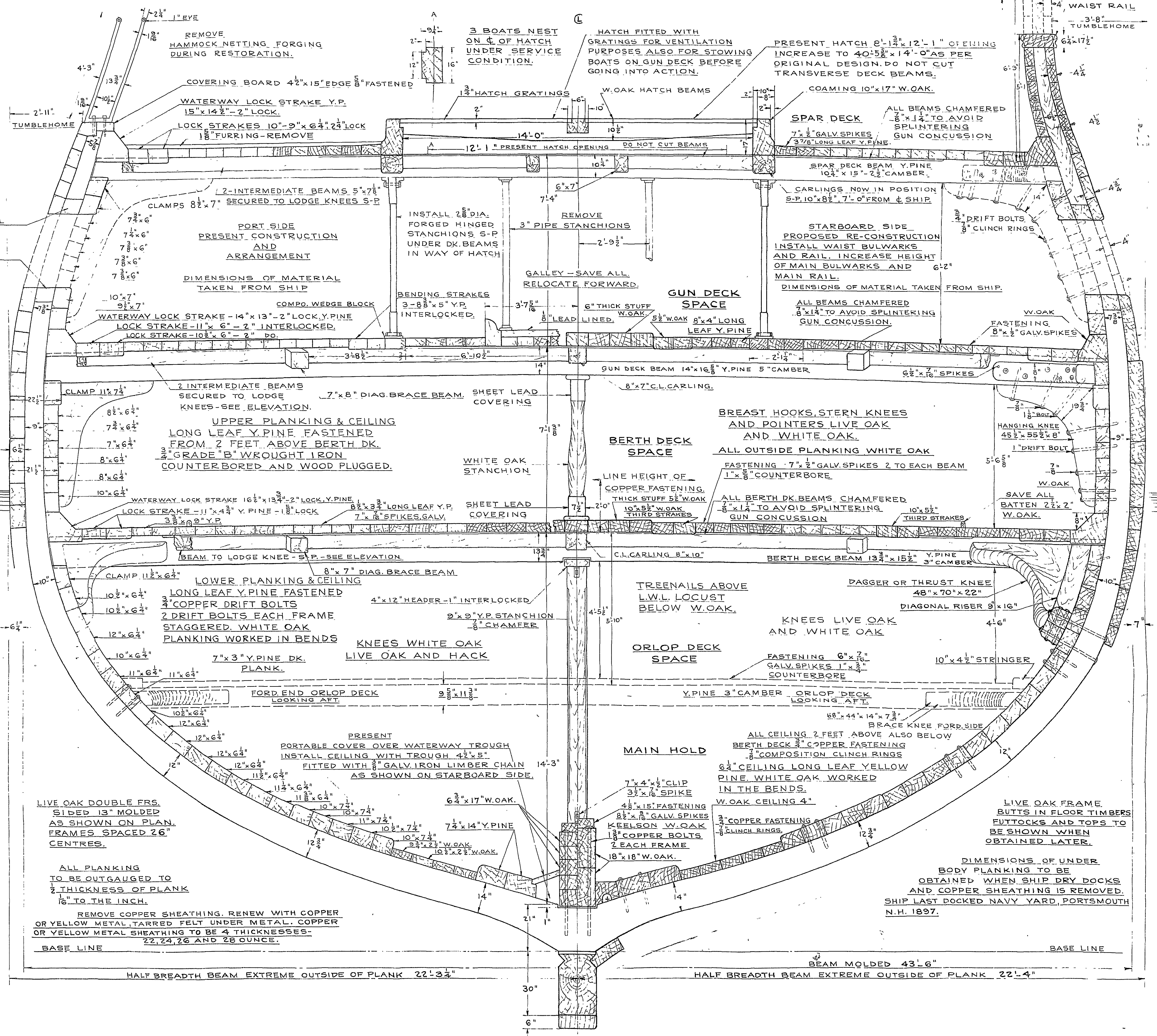
